BUY**TP 18.3€****Up/Downside: 90%****Good 1Q26**

Sales 1Q26 in line with exp and solid performance of core revenues (c. +7% YoY).

Sales performance in 1Q is in line with exp.

1Q26: core revenues = total excluding Bandi Scuola +6.8% YoY, total sales = € 14.2mn, +2% YoY.

We believe that at this pace Intred could reach c. € 59mn in sales and c. € 27mn in EBITDA (we have slightly increased our estimates).

Results were driven by ultra-broadband (+11.3%, c. € 6.8mn / € 14.2mn = 48% of total).

The company mentions territorial expansion driven by investments (costs) in marketing (despite this, we believe the EBITDA margin at year-end could be c. 46%). The geographic mix in Lombardy continues to expand, with: Brescia c. 58%, Bergamo 14% and Milan 12%. Network: +1,000 km in 1 year (total = 15,000 km).

The uplisting process on the STAR segment continues, which we believe will bring greater visibility to the stock.

BUY confirmed.

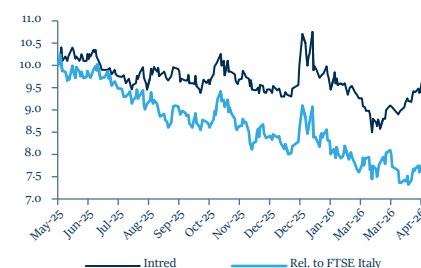

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Methodology

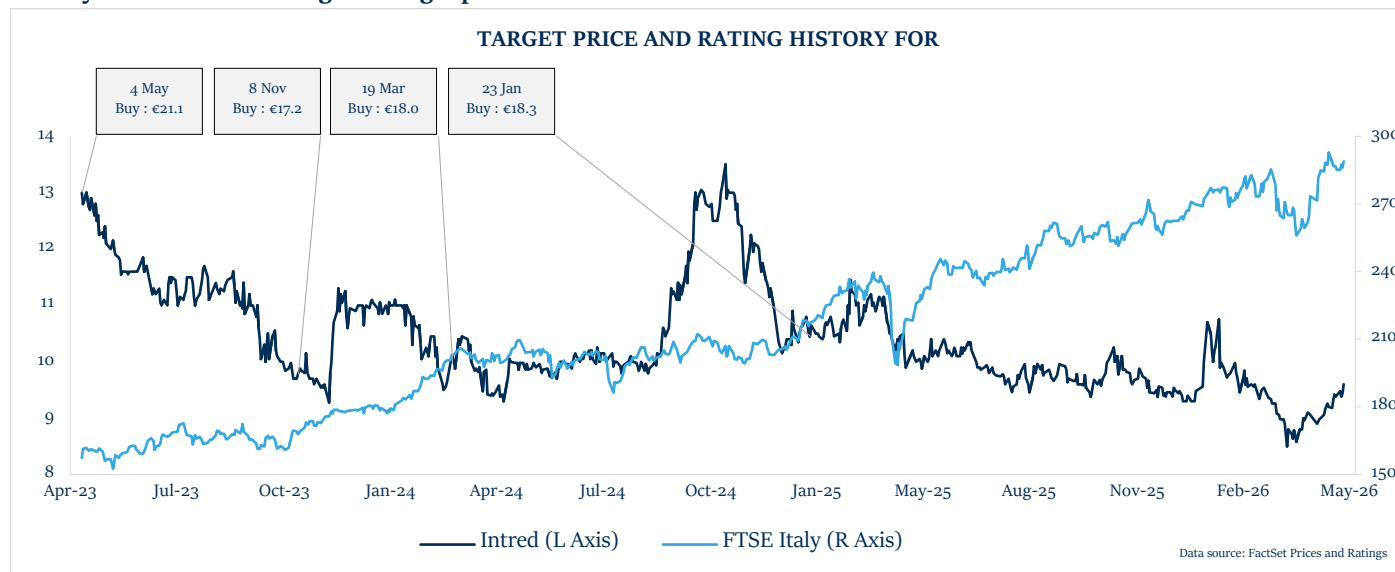
This Report may mention evaluation methods defined as follows:

1. DCF method: discounting of future cash flows generated by the company's operations. Cash flows are determined by the analyst's financial forecasts and models. The discount rate used corresponds to the weighted average cost of capital, which is defined as the weighted average cost of the company's debt and the theoretical cost of its equity as estimated by the analyst.
2. Comparable method: application of market valuation multiples or those observed in recent transactions. These multiples can be used as references and applied to the company's financial aggregates to deduce its valuation. The sample is selected by the analyst based on the characteristics of the company (size, growth, profitability, etc.). The analyst may also apply a premium/discount depending on his perception of the company's characteristics.
3. Assets and liabilities method: estimate of the value of equity capital based on revalued assets adjusted for the value of the debt.
4. Discounted dividend method: discounting of estimated future dividend flows. The discount rate used is generally the cost of capital.
5. Sum of the parts: this method consists of estimating the various activities of a company using the most appropriate valuation method for each of them, then realizing the sum of the parts.
